## My Journey, Choice of Subjects - Option Form

- Choose **one (1)** of the two routes and fill in only one (1) form for the route you have chosen. Fill in your order of preference as explained in the form.

Route 1. Secondary Education Certificate (SEC) Route presents all the SEC academic and vocational subjects. These subjects are certified by MATSEC.

Route 2. SEAC/SEC Route allows the possibility to choose TWO SEAC subjects or ONE SEAC and ONE SEC subject.

- Vocational and Applied Subjects will be available in clusters of schools as shown on Page 4. If a vocational or applied subject is not available in your College, it will be available in another College school within your cluster and you will be able to transfer **full time** to this school. There will be no need to change uniform and transport will be provided. It is very important to ensure that if you choose two (2) vocational or applied subjects, both subjects are available in the school you will attend.
- **While every effort will be made to offer all option subjects, this may not always be possible. In that case, students will be offered alternative option subjects.**
- Please return the form to your school by the closing date given to you by your respective school.
